


Celebrating Year 11 Success with the Class of 2025


Congratulations to our Year 11 students on all that they have achieved-

not just in the grades they have collected today, but in the people that they have become, the individual progress they have made and the determination, hard work and positivity that has characterised their journeys.



We are delighted to be able to **celebrate the significant number of top grades**, with 41% of our students achieving between one and 13 x 7-9 grades and a core group of students, some of whom we celebrate below, achieving between eight and 13 of these top grades each. In total our students achieved 396 top grades between them, a remarkable accomplishment that speaks to their dedication and the support of our school community.

This cohort were in the final year of primary when the pandemic hit in 2020, cancelling their key stage 2 tests and disrupting their transition to secondary school, so we are particularly proud of their fantastic achievements.



Success is of course relative to each individual and **we celebrate and congratulate all students whose individual grades, across the grade spectrum, reflect exceptional progress** during their time at Brentside.

These results are a testament to the commitment of our students, the encouragement and support of families and carers the expertise of our staff. We are excited to see what the future holds for each of our students.

- Yousra: Grade 9 x 3, Grade 8 x 1, Grade 7 x 4, Grade 6 x 2
- Jasmeet: Grade 9 x 2, Grade 8 x 2, Grade 7 x 1, Grade 6 x 7

We also celebrate some exceptional performances across subject areas, with 100% achieving 5-9 grades in physics, (and 75% achieving 7-9 grades,) as well as 98% of students achieving 5-9 grades in Biology, and 93% of students achieving 5-9 grades in Chemistry. Particularly strong individual performances are also evident in English Language and Literature, History, French, Spanish and Mathematics. We are especially proud of successes in citizenship, (studied by 123 students,) with 66% achieving a grade 5-9, a subject we place great value on, reinforcing British Values and enabling our students to understand and participate in the governance and politics of our country.



Looking Ahead: Sixth Form and Beyond

Every year, the majority of our Year 11 students continue their journey with us at Brentside High School Sixth Form, rated *Outstanding* by Ofsted in 2025. Following last week's exceptional post-16 results, we are excited to welcome our new Year 12 cohort in September and support them as they take their next steps.

This year's Sixth Form outcomes are set to surpass even last year's impressive achievements, which placed us in the top 15% nationally for A Level results, the top 16% for BTEC Level 3, and the top 5% for BTEC Level 2. For more details on these results, please see [here](#).
