Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Year 11 Mock Examinations

We are writing to inform you that the mock examinations for Year 11 start on **Thursday, 4 December and end on Friday, 19 December 2025.**

Students will be in normal lessons period 1 and 2 and tutor time as normal on Thursday, 4 December, apart from when they are sitting this mock examination.

The first examination will start at 11:15 and will be English Literature Paper 2. It will benefit students for these assessments to be as similar as possible to the GCSE examinations they will sit in the summer. **As part of this, if you give permission, your child will be allowed to leave the school site when they do not have a mock examination in the afternoon from Thursday, 4 December to Friday, 19 December 2025. During these dates, they can also arrive on site in time for their mock examination.**

We will send another email out with the examination timetable and will upload it to our website once done. It is the student's responsibility to bring in the appropriate equipment for all mock examinations.

The mock examinations form a very important part of the assessment process and will help with checking what has been learnt so far at Key Stage 4. All subjects have provided specific revision resources which can be found on ClassCharts, Seneca, Sparx, BBC Bitesize and Quizlet.
