Booking appointments

Parents/carers need to book appointments through the Parents' Evening System with this link <https://brentsidehigh.schoolcloud.co.uk/>. **We will inform you once the booking system is open and when appointments can be made.**

You are able to invite another parent to join the meeting (or perhaps to allow your child to join the meeting from home if you join the appointment from work). See [this webpage](#) for details of how to do this – but note that you will need to do this before your appointments start.

Inevitably, spaces for the teachers of some subjects will book up quickly. We would remind you that, should this be the case, you are able to contact teachers by email or telephone the school to request an alternative meeting.

In order for us to meet as many parents as possible, each appointment will last six minutes, and the meeting **will cut out** at exactly six minutes so please do not think that the teacher is hanging up on you! The outline of each appointment should broadly include:

- How your child is progressing in their study of the subject at Brentside
- A review of their mock examination outcome – their successes and future areas of focus and
- Priorities for the remainder of the year, including preparation for any future assessments.
