Year 12 Virtual Parents' Evening – SchoolCloud Video Appointments

I would like to invite you to the Year 12 Virtual Parents' Consultation Evening on Thursday, 12 February 2026, between 16:30 and 19:30. You will have the opportunity to discuss your child's progress with subject teachers. All students are expected to attend the evening remotely with their parents/carers. In line with most other Ealing High Schools, we are using SchoolCloud, an online video and audio call system for parent/carers to use to attend the parents' evenings remotely. To do this, you will need to log in using the parents' guide attached.

Booking appointments

Parents/carers need to book appointments through the Parents' Evening System with this link <https://brentsidehigh.schoolcloud.co.uk/>. **We will inform you once the booking system is open and when appointments can be made.**

You are able to invite another parent to join the meeting (or perhaps to allow your child to join the meeting from home if you join the appointment from work). See [this webpage](#) for details of how to do this – but note that you will need to do this before your appointments start. Inevitably, spaces for the teachers of some subjects will book up quickly. We would remind you that, should this be the case, you are able to contact teachers by email or telephone the school to request an alternative meeting.

In order for us to meet as many parents as possible, each appointment will last 6 minutes, and the meeting will cut out at exactly 6 minutes so please do not think that the teacher is hanging up on you! The outline of each appointment should broadly include:

- How your child is progressing in their study of the subject at Brentside
- Priorities for the remainder of the year, including preparation for any future assessments.

Please use the meeting time to focus on the learning that needs to take place for your child to develop a high level of understanding and skill in the subject based on their progress so far.
