**We are incredibly proud of our students and congratulate them on their excellent examination results.** With a national return to pre-pandemic grading, we are very pleased to be able to celebrate the successes of our students, many of whom have secured a significant number of the top grades.

**We are delighted that 42% of our students achieved one or more 7-9 grades (A/A\*) and 21 of our young people achieved between 8 and 13 of these top grades each.**
