Key Stage 5

Year 13 Alps* grade – Outstanding (within the top 1% of schools in England)

In both 2017 and 2018 our A level outcomes were in the top 2% of schools in England (there are no national comparators available for 2020 and 2021) and our rolling average is within the top 10%.

* Alps is a national data set that uses DfE data to compare progress made by students in each school at Key Stages 4 and 5 against progress of all students of similar ability and in similar subjects nationally.

^ The EBacc refers to a combination of subjects including: English, mathematics, science, geography or history and a modern foreign language. Our EBacc entry rate of 81% is significantly above the national entry rate of 40%.
